

ASSEMBLING INSTRUCTIONS RONI-GI FOR GLOCK MODELS







Step 1.

Pull the two safety pins out by pushing them thru the RONI (#1 & #2).

Pull the butt stock to full extension by pressing the button on the rear side of the stock (#3).

PLS1/34

Slim shape & low profile polymer Picatinny light/laser mount.

Diameter: 1" (25.4mm)/0.75" (19mm)

#PLS1/34 - screw tightened. #PLS1Q/34Q- quick-release.



Vortex Tactical Flashlight 1 Watt Luxeon® LED. Water & Shock Resistant.







Open forearm-grip to vertical position (#4) by pushing (if equipped with folding forearm-grip).



release button (#5), and swinging grip down into position

Lay the RONI down on its side. If you are looking at the pistol laying down, the muzzle should be pointing left. Slide parts #6 & #7 to fully extended positions.

Push button heavy duty sling swivel.





SIP/SQA

One or two point heavy duty sling uses #PBSS.



Open the body on its bottom hinge (#8).



Step 7.

Place pistol directly into position making sure it is laying flat. The under barrel rail slot on the Glock needs engage the male rail bar on the RONI.

In order for the RONI to close properly, make sure the pistol and slide attachment are locked into position before folding hinged body back over.




Place the polymer slide attachment (#9) to the rear of the slide.



Step 8.

Changing between shorter Glocks (such as 19, 23, 25, 32) to the longer version (such as 17, 22, 31, 34, 35), unscrew #10. Then, adjust #11 to the accurate position, so you can re-screw it securely. To be sure that the fitting is correct, you <u>must</u> insure the next step (#9).



Step 9.

Push muzzle on RONI (#7) up against Glock. Make sure that part #11 covers the barrel of the pistol as pictured above and make sure the screw is well tightened (#10).



Step 10.

IMPORTANT: make sure that both safety-catchs (#9) are locked at the same position.

Close the body (#8) and push parts #6 & #7 back together into locking position, then place pins back into place.
